

Ramenki: Leading with the landscape in Moscow

Prominent Russian developer, Don-Stroy Invest, has appointed LDA Design to masterplan a 55ha site, south-west of the city centre in the Ramenki District, close to Moscow State University. The proposal will create over one million sqm of mixed-use development, including 10,000 homes, two new schools, kindergartens, community facilities, shops and commercial workspace.

The Ramenki development builds upon LDA Design's growing profile in Moscow, with projects such as the restoration of iconic Gorky Park; our masterplan for multiple parks across the Russian capital and our work on the new airport city masterplan at Molzhaninovo.

It also follows the successful masterplan for the 60 ha former Serp and Molot steelworks site undertaken by LDA Design, also for Don-stroy Invest. This €3.85 billion mixed-use development, now known as Symbol, gained planning approval in 2015.

The Ramenki team includes UHA Architects London and Proektus, a Russian architectural bureau responsible for project support and advice on local urban design regulations.
